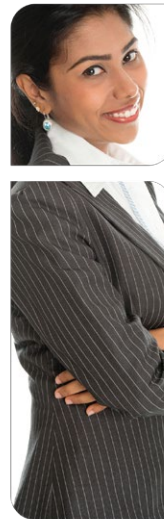

## Islamic Capital Market Graduate Training Scheme

The Islamic Capital Market Graduate Training Scheme (ICMGTS) is intended to create a pool of capital market talent to facilitate the development of the Islamic Capital Market (ICM) in Malaysia. Funded by the Capital Market Development Fund (CMDf), the ICMGTS provides an avenue for graduates to acquire the right skill set and fundamental knowledge of ICM. Emphasis is placed on producing

forward-thinking professionals with sound technical knowledge and good communication skills. Essentially, the ICMGTS provides a comprehensive overview of the ICM and the relevant Syariah principles based on various teaching methodologies, comprising lectures, illustrative examples, case studies and simulations that can be readily applied to the real world.

- Regulatory Requirements and Legal Documentation in Islamic Capital Market
- Islamic Equity Market
- Sukuk Market

### Soft Skill Modules

- English Business Communication
- Professional Grooming and Business Etiquette
- Leadership and Personal Development
- Business News Analysis
- Ethics and Integrity

### WHO Should Apply

1. Malaysian citizens
2. Aged 30 years and below
3. Possess excellent inter-personal and communication skills
4. Have at least a second class upper degree or its equivalent from a recognised institution of higher learning in any of the following or related fields:
  - **Accounting/Islamic Accounting**
  - **Banking/Islamic Banking**
  - **Economics/Islamic Economics**
  - **Finance/Islamic Finance**
  - **Legal**
  - **Shariah**
